



## 2010 CESifo Area Conference on Energy and Climate Economics



### Call for Papers

On October 15-16 2010, CESifo will organise the second CESifo Area Conference on Energy and Climate Economics in Munich for all members of the CESifo Research Network.

The purpose of the conference is to bring together CESifo members to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between them. All CESifo research network members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic in the field of Energy and Climate Economics.

The keynote speaker will be **Larry Karp**, University of California, Berkeley. The deadline for submission of complete papers, or 2-3 page abstract, is **August 6, 2010**. Preference will be given to complete papers.

Authors of submitted papers will be notified no later than August 31, 2009 as to whether their paper has been accepted for the workshop. Papers which are more related to the topic of other area conferences will be re-directed to the respective area coordinator. Please note that the **same paper** is allowed to be submitted to **only one** of the CESifo area conferences.

CESifo will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy travel costs for CESifo Research Fellows/Affiliates with accepted papers. All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series. Other network members are invited to attend, but are expected to provide their own funding for travel and accommodation.

### Distinguished CESifo Affiliate - Call for Nominations

In an effort to encourage talented young scholars, CESifo has instituted the "Distinguished CESifo Affiliate" prize, to be awarded to a young author (up to age 35) of the best paper nominated in connection with the CESifo Area Conference on Energy and Climate Economics. The criteria for the award will be scientific originality, policy relevance and quality of exposition. The prize winner will receive €3000.

All CESifo Research Fellows are welcome to **nominate candidates** for the award (please note that it is not mandatory for candidates to be from the research network). To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit the nominee's paper to Michael Hoel, University of Oslo ([mihoel@econ.uio.no](mailto:mihoel@econ.uio.no)), along with a letter explaining the motivation for the nomination. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series.
