



## 2010 CESifo Area Conference on Employment and Social Protection



### Call for Papers

On May 14-15 2010, CESifo will organise the annual CESifo Area Conference on Employment and Social Protection in Munich for all members of the CESifo Research Network with an interest in this research area.

The purpose of the workshop is to bring together CESifo members to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between them. All CESifo Research Network members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic within the domains of employment and social protection. Both domains are to be broadly defined, the former including, in particular, issues of the organisation of labour. The latter domain, in turn, includes not only governmental institutions of the welfare state, like social insurance, but also other non-governmental institutions of the welfare society, such as the family, or charities and informal networks, social norms and altruistic behaviour.

The keynote speaker will be **Francis Bloch** from Ecole Polytechnique, Paris.

The **deadline for submission** of complete papers, or 2-3 page abstracts, is **February 15, 2010**. Preference will be given to complete papers.

Please note that the **same paper** is allowed to be submitted to **only one** of the CESifo area conferences. Authors of submitted papers will be notified no later than March 8, 2009 as to whether their paper has been accepted for the workshop. Papers which are more related to the topic of other area conferences will be re-directed to the respective area coordinator.

CESifo will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy travel costs for CESifo Research Fellows/Affiliates with accepted papers. All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series. Other network members are invited to attend, but are expected to provide their own funding for travel and accommodation.

## **Distinguished CESifo Affiliate - Call for Nominations**

In an effort to encourage talented young scholars, CESifo has instituted the "Distinguished CESifo Affiliate" prize, to be awarded to a young author (below the age of 35) of the best paper presented at the CESifo Area Conference on Employment and Social Protection. The criteria for the award will be scientific originality, policy relevance and quality of exposition. The prize winner will receive €3000.

All CESifo Research Fellows are welcome to nominate candidates for the award (please note that it is not mandatory for candidates to be from the research network). To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit the nominee's paper to Kai Konrad, Max Planck Institute for Intellectual Property, Competition and Tax Law ([kai.konrad@ip.mpg.de](mailto:kai.konrad@ip.mpg.de)), along with a letter explaining the motivation for the nomination. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series.
