CESifo Conference on “Law and Economics”

On **28 - 29 May** 2010, CESifo and the Department of Law, Governance & Economics at European Business School (EBS) will organize a joint workshop on Law and Economics.

The conference is intended to encourage further research in the different areas of Law and Economics such as Behavioural Law and Economics, Commercial Law, Contract Law, Criminal Law, Environmental Law and Economics, Experimental Law and Economics, Family Law, Gender and Discrimination, Health Law, Intellectual Property and Innovation Policy, Labour and Employment Law, Litigation, Dispute Resolution and the Legal Process, Property Law, Public and Administrative Law as well as Tort Law and Compensation.

The deadline for submissions is 15 January 2010. For submission of (full) papers, please visit www.CESifo.de. Authors of submitted papers will be notified as soon as possible, at latest at the end of February 2010, as to whether their paper has been accepted for the conference.

CESifo will provide accommodation and reimburse economy travel costs for researchers presenting an accepted paper. Others are invited to attend, but are expected to provide their own funding for travel and accommodation.

All papers presented at the conference are expected to be submitted to a conference volume published by European Journal of Law and Economics in a special issue. Papers not included in the conference volume will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series after revision.
