Authors of submitted papers will be notified before **31 July 2011** whether their paper has been accepted for the conference. Preference is given to papers over abstracts.

Presenters may be asked to discuss a paper at the conference.

All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series.
