On **16th and 17th of June** 2011, the Institut de recherches économiques et sociales (IRES) at Université catholique de Louvain and CESifo will organise a joint workshop on taxation, transfers and the labour market.

The purpose of the workshop is to stimulate research in the taxation literature in its' relation to the labour market and to bring together high-profile researchers with younger colleagues. Particular emphasis of the workshop will be placed on such topics as optimal redistributive taxation, taxation and labour market participation, optimal social insurance and taxation in an imperfect labour market. Submissions from theoretical and applied fields are equally encouraged.

The keynote speech will be delivered by **Robin Boadway**, Queen's University.

The deadline for submissions is **1st of March** 2011. Authors of submitted papers will be notified about acceptance by the end of March 2011 at the latest.
