Workshop description

The increasing internationalisation of firms raises many difficult questions for the taxation of corporate income. For example, how do differences in taxes between jurisdictions affect the location of firms, capital and profit? To what extent can, and should, governments compete with each other to influence these location decisions? Is the traditional source-based tax feasible in the long run – and are there any reasonable alternatives? How important are tax havens? How important is information sharing between governments? The purpose of this workshop is to discuss original contributions on these and related questions.

All papers presented at the workshop are eligible for submission to the CESifo Working Paper Series. Moreover, we consider publishing a selection of the papers in a special issue of a refereed international journal. Details will be announced as we get closer to the final workshop.
