## Workshop description

The aim of the conference is to bring together researchers interested in the study of the determinants of illicit trade. The main focus of the conference will be drug trade, counterfeiting and arms smuggling.

This workshop intends to analyse the impact that globalisation may have had on the volume and nature of illicit trade. Consequently, we look for theoretical and empirical contributions which analyse and measure the mechanisms through which globalisation has changed the different forms of illicit trade (for instance in terms of its volume, value, and organisational structure).
