From 2 May to 3 May, 2001 *CESifo* will organise a workshop on public pensions to be held in Munich. Keynote lectures will be presented by Gary Burtless, Brookings Institute, and Pierre Pestieau, University of Liège.

Theoretical and empirical papers are particularly welcome in the following areas of pension research:

- Coping with Demographic Transition
- Pros and Cons of Compulsory Membership
- Dynastic Altruism
- Intra- and Intergenerational Redistribution
- Political Economy in Ageing Societies
- Timing Retirement
- Risk and Regulation of Pension Systems

Submission of papers or a 2-3 page abstract should be sent in triplicate to the CESifo Office: CESifo, Poschingerstrasse 5, 81679 Munich, Germany. A pdf file of the paper should be sent either by e-mail to office@cesifo.de or on a diskette to the office address. The deadline for submission is 15 February 2001. CESifo will reimburse economy travel and accommodation for **CESifo Fellows** with accepted papers. Other authors with accepted papers may apply for limited funding to cover accommodation and/or economy travel.
