### **Call for Abstracts**

#### **CESifo–Delphi Conferences on *Managing EU Enlargement***

CESifo and the Department of International and European Economic Studies (DIEES) of the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB) ask for submission of extended abstracts (300-500 words) on the question of “Managing EU Enlargement” for the CESifo–Delphi Conferences in 2001/2002. Relevant topics include issues such as trade and factor mobility, monetary and fiscal policy, and the decision-making structure in the European Union. Preference is given to policy papers with a theoretical background or applied work addressing important policy issues.

The CESifo–Delphi Conferences work as a two-stage process. Authors of accepted papers will be invited to give short presentations at a workshop meeting in Munich, 14-15 December 2001. Selected authors are then invited to present (possibly revised) versions of their papers at a conference meeting in Delphi, 12-14 September 2002. The papers will be published in the CESifo Seminar Series with MIT Press. There will be external refereeing of papers after both stages.

Abstracts should be submitted by 31 December 2000. A decision on accepted abstracts will be announced by the end of January 2001. Full papers must then be submitted by the end of July 2001. Authors will be notified of the decision to accept their paper for the Munich meeting by early October 2001.
