CESifo Area Conference on Applied Microeconomics

On March 10-11, 2006 CESifo will organise a conference in Munich for all members of the CESifo Research Network with an interest in the area of Applied Microeconomics. The purpose of the conference is to bring together CESifo members to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between them. All CESifo research network members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic within the broad domain of Applied Microeconomics (industrial organisation, experimental and behavioural economics, market regulation, banking and finance, auctions)

The keynote speaker will be David Encaoua (Université de Paris-I, Panthéon-Sorbonne). The deadline for submission of papers, or a 2-3 page abstract is January 10, 2006. CESifo research network members interested in presenting a paper should send their paper or extended abstracts to the conference organiser:

Submission of papers to Christian Gollier by e-mail (in pdf format) is welcome. Authors of submitted papers will be notified no later than 23rd January 2006 whether their paper has been accepted for the conference.

CESifo will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy travel costs for CESifo Research Fellows/Affiliates with accepted papers. Other network members are invited to participate, but are expected to provide their own funding for travel and accommodation. Further questions regarding the organisation and scientific content of the conference should be addressed to the conference organiser.

The same paper is only allowed to be submitted to one of the five CESifo area conferences. Papers which are more related to the topic of other area conferences will be re-directed to the respective area coordinator.
