CESifo Area Conference on Employment and Social Protection

On May 26-27 2006, CESifo will organise a workshop in Munich for all members of the CESifo Research Network with an interest in the area of Employment and Social Protection.

The purpose of the workshop is to bring together CESifo members to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between them. All CESifo Research Network members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic within the domains of employment and social protection. Both domains are to be broadly defined, the former including, in particular, issues of the organisation of labour. The latter domain, in turn, includes not only governmental institutions of the welfare state, like social insurance, but also other non-governmental institutions of the welfare society, such as the family, or charities and informal networks, social norms and altruistic behaviour.

The keynote speaker will be Robert A. Pollak (Washington University in St. Louis). The deadline for submission of papers, or a 2-3 page abstract, is **February 20, 2006**. CESifo research network members interested in presenting a paper should send their proposal to the workshop organiser:

Submission of papers to Kai Konrad by e-mail (in pdf format) is welcome. Authors of submitted papers will be notified no later than **March 12, 2006** as to whether their paper has been accepted for the workshop.

CESifo will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy travel costs for CESifo Research Fellows/Affiliates with accepted papers. Other network members are invited to attend, but are expected to provide their own funding for travel and accommodation.

The same paper is only allowed to be submitted to one of the five CESifo area conferences.
