Call for Papers

CESifo Area Conference on Public Sector Economics

On **21-23 April 2006**, CESifo will organise a conference in Munich for members of the Public Sector Economics area of the CESifo Research Network.

The conference is intended to give an overview of the current research undertaken by members of the Public Sector Economics area of the network and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between area members. All CESifo research network members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic in Public Economics. The **keynote speaker** will be **Dirk Krueger (Goethe University, Frankfurt)** who is well known for his path-breaking contributions in the fields of public finance and macroeconomics. His **keynote lecture** will be on the topic of **social security, risk and missing financial markets**.

The deadline for submission of papers or abstracts is **20 February 2006**. CESifo research network members interested in presenting a paper should e-mail their paper and a 2-3 page abstract to the conference organiser:

Submission of papers to Rick van der Ploeg by e-mail (in pdf format) is welcome. Authors of submitted papers will be notified before 5 March 2006 whether their paper has been accepted for the conference. Preference is given to papers over abstracts.

CESifo provides accommodation, and will reimburse economy travel costs for CESifo Research Fellows / Affiliates with accepted papers. Other network members are invited to attend, but are expected to provide their own funding for travel and accommodation.

The same paper is only allowed to be submitted to one of the five CESifo area conferences. Since the area of Public Sector Economics has more CESifo Fellows than any other of the CESifo areas, we encourage fellows /affiliates to submit to one of the other CESifo area conferences whenever possible. Papers which are more related to the topic of other area conferences will be re-directed to the respective area coordinator.
