### **“Government, Institutions, and Macroeconomic Performance”**

for the CESifo–Delphi Conference, May 30-31, 2008. Relevant topics include issues such as:

- measures of institutional quality
- bureaucracy, property rights, corruption and political stability
- institutions, investment and growth
- economic policy and institutions
- sclerosis and reforms
- the role of economic integration
- globalization and institutional choice
- determinants of institutions
- other topics along these lines

Applied theoretical and empirical work that stresses policy implications is particularly welcome.

Selected papers from the conference will be published in a special issue of the **European Journal of Political Economy** subject to a referee process.

Full papers or extended abstracts (400-600 words) should be sent as a pdf-file to the scientific organizers (see below), by **December 31, 2007**.

A decision **on accepted papers for presentation** at the conference will be announced by **January 31, 2008**.

Authors with accepted papers will have their meals and accommodation provided and their economy travel costs reimbursed. All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series.
